

STEPS TO VICTORY IN YOUR LIFE

HOW TO HAVE VICTORY OVER THE "WORLD"

A. IDENTIFY YOUR ENEMY:

When the Bible speaks of the "world" in the context of opposition to you, it is **not** referring to God's creation but to the "world *system*," which is organized on selfish principles, improper motives, ungodly standards, and which is opposed to the will of God.


